## **Old Business/Unfinished Business:**

- 1. The County Commissioners appointed Brian Dirks to replace Willy Acton.
- 2. Pilots Lounge Bid/Construction has been awarded to Arnzen Building Construction

## **New Business:**

- 1. No new business presented to the Airport Advisory Board from the Commissioners.
- 2. Mike Cook briefed the Advisory Board on the following upcoming airport business:
  - Idaho Dept. of Aeronautics paid for some taxiway work allowing the County to repurpose approximately \$89,000 in funds toward the airport lounge/business office project. Originally the scope of the project awarded to Arzen Building Construction did not include the planned garage. Now with these additional available funds the garage will be completed in conjunction with the rest of the project. Planned completion is no later than June 30, 2024.
  - The airport web cam project is gaining traction and supported by all involved parties.
  - A Precision Approach Path Indicator (PAPI) system is in the planning stages for both runways 08/26.
  - A 2024 seal coat, crack fill, and marking project is planned for the runways and taxiways including the taxi lanes using FAA and Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) funds.
- Ken Kuther discussed and had some suggestions on airport use fees as they it pertains to ag operations
