

Idaho County Airport Snow Removal Plan

(03/01/2025)

Idaho County Snowplowing will start no later than 6:00 a.m. with the following priorities:

1. Life Flight Helicopter Area
Idaho County Road Crew will clear this area prior to departure for bus routes, etc. This Removal should be completed by 6:30 a.m.
2. Runway & Taxiway, Apron and Tie down Area
The Airport Site Manager is responsible for snow removal. Dependent upon the amount and weight of snow, this will take 2-4 hours. If it is determined that the removal is beyond the capability of the Airport Site Manager, the Idaho County Road Crew (if available) or a contractor will be called to assist.
3. Hanger Taxilanes-West End on as needed basis.

Contacts have been and will continue between Airport personnel and frequent users such as Life flight, UPS(AirPac), J Frei and Flying B Charters.

Notam's will be issued as needed for:

- Equipment working on Airport surfaces
- Airport Closure if conditions require

-Dependent on snowfall and visibility continuing beyond 0600

additional resources (Contractors, Road Crew) may be needed

to get airport opened as quickly as possible when conditions allow.

-Height of berms from plowing along runway/taxiway may

require grader type/loader, etc. to lower berms for low wing aircraft.
